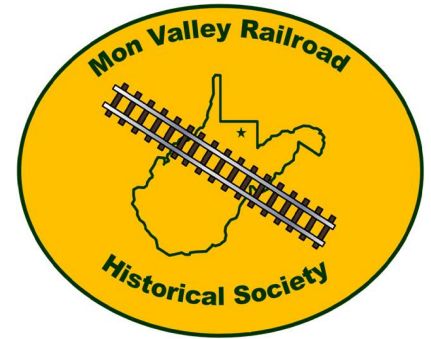

Ad Cars: Rich was contacted by The Black Bear and they want to continue to sponsor a car. Rich refurbished their car. Animal Friends Thrift shop has renewed. Eric is starting his campaign for the upcoming year. Bob asked the cost of an Ad Car. Rich said \$35 plus \$5 for set up. Renewals are \$35.

Membership: Jay Farling submitted an application for a youth membership. Originally, the Farlings had joined as a family membership, but desire to change to one Adult and one Youth membership. Keith motioned that their membership be amended to one Adult and one Youth. Ken put forth a second. Motion voted and approved.

Donations: Rich started a "Giving Tuesday" FB Page and has received \$14 so far. The Kruger Street Toy and Train Museum as also started a "Giving Tuesday" Page for us. Nathan Marcus donated multiple boxes of engines, rolling stock, and assorted modeling items that were left from an estate sale. They are available for members to purchase. What is left will be out for sale at our upcoming Open Houses.

Jeremy brought a box of assorted N scale items that he received as a donation.

Old Business: The box from Steve Raque contained a G scale engine and some cars. John has some track he will bring in before the Open House.

New Business: Keith made a motion that a 12 x 24 O scale layout be built using some materials having already been acquired. The layout to fit Rich's Track Plan. Second by Ken. Voted on and approved. Ken announced that **OLLI** asked

him to teach an "Intro to Model Railroading". The class would be on January 22nd, Ken would open with a one hour Introduction and then conduct a tour of our society. Ken requested approval to conduct the tour and it was approved

2. Keep one or two modules for demonstration purposes.
3. Keith made a motion to approve Ken's requests. Rich offered a second. Voted on and approved.

Main Layout: Rich reported that construction of the Main Layout began on December 1st.

Eric printed the Track Plan to scale that can be used as a template for cutting materials.

Until further notice, construction work will be conducted at the society on Wednesday's from 9am til noon.

Keith, Bob, Gary, and Rich worked on construction of Gary's "Dispatcher's Office".

Bill pointed out that some of the outlet boxes have gone dead. Further investigation is being conducted.

Dave purchased 20 LED bulbs to replace the bulbs in the HO areas.

For the Good of the Order: Ken shared that because we are a Historical Society, someone gave him some railroad time tablet books for donation to the society and they will be placed in the display case.

Greg made a brief presentation of *Robert's Rules for Non-Profit Organizations* and also an outline/format of the new Agenda Sequence to be used during business meetings. Richard asked if the new format could be distributed to the membership by way of the

news letter. Greg is to furnish a copy to Rich who will get it incorporated into the next edition or send it out via email to all members.

Sunday March 20th is the Division 2 meeting at the society. Doors to open at noon with the meeting to start at 2pm.

Rich gave encouraging remarks about the December 18 & 19 Holiday Open House and made a plea for helpers during the event. He will send out emails to the membership.

Greg made a motion to adjourn, to which Rich offered a second. The meeting was adjourned at 1945 (7:45pm).
