We received a \$10 donation through our Facebook page. Flyers are ready for the Spring Open House event coming up on April 15th and 16th. Rich will send a PDF copy to members to print and post as appropriate.

Business Express Ad Cars (Eric H.):

Nothing to report. (See the related sub-committee request for exploring new sources of revenue under new business.)

Membership (Rich H.):

Rich emailed eight members who hadn't yet paid, two of whom paid just prior to this meeting. With the loss of Lou Lemelle and two members not renewing, our total membership now stands at 37.

Donations (Rich H.):

Income from the Open House during the Empty Bowls event totaled \$140 for sales of used merchandise and monetary donations combined.

Old Business:

Bill H. announced that test track built with the old Digitrax DCC system for testing locomotives is now available for HO, with construction details still in progress. Testing ability for other scales will be available in the future.

New Business:

The president requested the formation of an ad hoc sub-committee tasked with revamping the Ad Car program and brainstorming new avenues for revenue generation. The sub-committee will report back to the membership at the next business meeting. Members of the subcommittee thus far include Eric H., Jon H., and Rich H. Others with fundraising ideas are welcome.

Dave E. inquired about the wooden

trestle donated to the Society some years ago, which is reminiscent of a trestle on the PRR near his grandmother's home. The ensuing discussion pointed toward a possible diorama featuring the trestle.

LAYOUTS: O Gauge (Rich H.):

Full operation by the Spring Open House remains the goal for the O scale layout. The O scale team continues to lay track and debug occasional electrical issues. The inside grade is progressing as are the bridge and upper level.

HO Scale:(Richard T.)

The current focus for the HO scale team is the upper level Eleanor mine at Igot over Easton staging. The power bus and drop wires are now installed on the grade leading to the mine. The HO layout is expected to be operational on the lower level and up to the Eleanor mine in time for the NMRA MCR Division II meeting hosted by the MVRHRS on March 19th, 2023. In addition to track laying and wiring, a majority of track has been painted by hand or airbrush. Beyond the Division II event, the HO team hopes to complete the entire upper level in time for the January 1st, 2024 operating session.

N Scale Layout: (Max M.):

The N scale track plan remains under review of operational aspects, but moving closer something presentable to the membership. A budget will be ready for the April business meeting.

Dave E. suggested adding the plexiglass protectors from the old modules to the N scale layout.

For the Good of the Order:

Keith D. reported that a substantial quantity of HO code 83 flex track was salvaged from the former Dick Flock layout for use by the Society.

Bill H. asked that members be more cautious about discarding items that may be saved by others. Some track that he'd been saving for someone was put in the trash recently. Labeling and bagging items to be saved may help avoid misunderstandings. There remains an ongoing need to cull unneeded items.

In the same vein of moving items no longer of value to the Society, the president recommended a date label on sale items to help in sorting those destined for the "free" bin / table.

Keith D. suggested consigning appropriate items to the MCR Rails to Pittsburgh white elephant sale.

Jon H. suggested eBay as another possible channel for moving sale items.

Motion to adjourn by Rich H., with multiple seconds, at 7:41 PM
