Old Business:

OLLI class Saturday, December 3rd (Kenton C.) 10 AM – 12 PM. Volunteers sought for 11AM – noon portion. Several members indicated that they would be there to help.

Naming Committee Report (Eric H.):

All major yards and staging areas are now named, as are adjacent communities. This will help clarify future plans and discussions involving specific locations.

DCC System (Keith D.): Our offer for the purchase of the former Dick Flock layout NCE wired DCC system was accepted. Volunteers sought to help in dismantling the system in order to bring it back to the MVRRHS. A radio communication subsystem may be added later.

Christmas Open House (Rich H.): Repeated call to volunteer to crew the Open House. Santa and Mrs. Claus chairs inspected. More cleaning to do before the date.

New Business:

(Keith D.)

(Dave E.)

Society materials in unauthorized areas in back of the shop. Need to move under layouts, use or discard.

Open vent fans in the former kitchen area need to be blocked in order to reduce heat loss.

LAYOUTS: O Gauge (Rich H.):

Some limited progress over the past couple of weeks. Grades are mostly built. Uncoupling tracks need to be installed. The inside loop will not be in operation during the Open House. (Dave E.): Control panel design in progress. Overall looking good and trains will be running.

Track laying progresses apace in

HO Scale:

Easton and West Allegheny staging yards. The HO layout is generally looking "railroady". Focus will shift to switching locations/industries as track laying winds up in the staging areas. The supply of switches on hand remains sufficient, though an inventory is in order once the current scope of work is done. More cork roadbed is needed. The next work session is set for Tuesday, December 6th. The HO layout task force should meet soon to plan the next phase, including a decision on starting the

second level over Easton Staging.

Design and testing of a support system for the mostly shallow upper level is needed. Gary D. added that additional wiring is planned, and there is limited workspace available at the West Allegheny Shops.

N Scale Layout (Wally V.)

The N scale layout backdrop supports will be used for bulletin boards until the backdrop is installed. Mike H. started a track plan in a model railroad CAD application (AnyRail) with input from Greg M. and Eric M. The aim is to have a plan done within the next one to two months. A repeat of the temporary Kato layout is planned for the Christmas Open House.

For the Good of the Order:

Keith D. plans to host an operating session on January 1st, 2023 starting at 9 AM. An email announcement will go out soon. Also from Keith: The Railroad Prototype Modelers association will meet at Westmoreland County Community College in Youngwood, PA next March 24th and 25th.

The Mid-Central Region Convention takes place over May 4th through 7th.

Dave E. stated that the concourse O scale layout brought in a significant amount last month, and that routine locomotive maintenance is needed, as well as some scenery updates and cleaning.

Mike H. urged members to identify materials that we need and prepare to discard what's not foreseeably of use. On a related note, a motion by Mike to release the old dehumidifier to Dave H. A second from Keith D. Motion approved unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 8:01 PM.
