Membership: The active roster presently lists 38 members. Rich will publish a new roster. Rich conducted a one question survey asking members if they had a home layout. Yes or No. There were 16 respondents. 7 "HO", 2 "O", 1 "N", and 1 "S".

Donations: An anonymous donation of the benchwork lumber and hardware for the "N" Scale project was reported.

Old Business: Election of Officers. On April 9th electronic Ballots were sent out via email by the Secretary. 22 Members responded. 22 members affirmed the nominations put forward by the Nominating Committee. The new officers will be transition in June and take over in July.

New Business: Rich made a point that we needed to confirm dates for the Open Houses for the rest of the calendar year. The 27th and 28th of August for the Back to School OH. November 5th is a one day OH for National Model Railroad Day. December 17 & 18 listed as a possible for the Holiday Open House. Mike stated we needed to have something running before the August OH. Keith made a motion we accept the dates listed above with a stipulation. If the "O" Scale Layout is not presentable to the public, by the last week of July; the Back to School OH be postponed or cancelled. Second to the motion offered by Mike. Voted and approved. Rich feels the outside loop "The Main" can be operational for the Back to School Open House.

Ken suggested another Open House in October. John Hebb presented a case against an October OH. The subject was dropped.

LAYOUTS

O: Jeremy and Jay have done some work and started on the extension. Rich laid out 2 curves and marked them off. Some track is still on backorder. After the outside turn is laid, he will trace the edges to create a guide for other turns. Rich requested 100 feet of 16 gauge wire (red, black, and white) as well and another sheet of plywood. He will create a "to do" list so members will be able to jump in and help at their own.

HO: Mike reported much of the roadbed is down. Homosote needs to be secured to the plywood. Presently progress is hung up on missing turnouts that are "on order". The wiring can begin. Gary asked for a "Really Large Radius turnout for the interlocking. Keith stated that since he will be paying the state, insurance and purchasing checks, we appropriate funds and he will do a bulk purchase of wire to meet the wiring needs for both HO and O scale. \$500 was the suggested appropriation, to which made a motion was made by Rich with a second from Eric. Voted on and approved.

Keith reported the HO committee wants to purchase the NCE Powerhouse Pro - 5 amp System. Rich proposed an allocation of \$1000which was seconded by Ken. Voted on and approved.

N: Greg reported that since the length of the N scale project was increased to 20 feet, additional benchwork is required. Greg is performing the construction at home for the convenience of setting up, breaking down, and cleaning which consumes large amounts of time when work is done at the society. Greg plans to have the completed structure at the society for the June Business Meeting. He requested assistance for the building of the support stands. Keith offered

to get with him after the meeting.

For the Good of the Order: Nothing.

Rich made a motion to adjourn, to which Ken offered a second. The meeting was adjourned at 2010 (8:10 pm).


