LAYOUTS:

N Scale Layout:

Max M. moved to accept layout plan as drawn and displayed on the N scale benchwork, second by Keith D., unanimous approval by members present. Wally V. stated the intent to purchase materials in the next week or so.

O Gauge (Rich H.):

Inside line done, more electrical drops needed. Layout ran well for the Open House. Materials needed: foam board, Gargraves track (on order with Jon H.). Dave E. reported progress on wire supports and other aspects of electrical wiring.

HO Scale (Gary D.):

The Signals Section reports that conduit is being installed for high and low voltage needs. ME industrial park track partially complete pending structure placement. Richard T. described benchwork progress over Chiefton and moving westward. Keith D. discussed second level progress and the need for plywood and electrical hangers. Cutting plywood for the complex curves of the North Bend peninsula proved challenging.

(Keith D.) The MVRRHs received a donation from Ward Paine's family in honor of a family member.
