Treasurer's report (Keith D.):
Financial transactions and status for the month of September, 2022. The MVRRHHS remains solvent and financially sound. DCC system on order. Interim solution of spare Lenz offered by Gary D. Jon Hebb offered DCC++ EX Arduino micro controller system. These alternatives may allow test operations until new system is installed.

Flyers and a request for member commitments to help are pending. The membership discussed placement of yard signs, possibly at member homes, and signage at Mall entrances.

Business Express Ad Cars (Eric H.):

Nothing to report. Dave E. stated that the bookshelf in the foyer is in place and further modifications are underway to accommodate add cars.

Membership (Rich H.):

No discussion at this meeting.

Donations:

\$16 on the previous Thursday. Trains / equipment - donated by Pamela Myers.

Richard T. expressed concern that inventory space for sale items is diminishing, indicating a need to cull non-salable items. The offer of "free" items at a future open house was discussed. Dave E. plans to store books on the shelved in the foyer.

Old Business: No items presented.

New Business: Ken C. reminded the membership of the railroad class that he taught last year at the Osher Life Long Learning Institute (OLLI). He is again teaching this class on Saturday, December 3rd, at 10 til 11:45 AM. A brief tour of the MVRRHs space is included. Members are requested to volunteer to be on hand to field questions.

Alzheimer's fundraising walk (Rich H.) - This even takes place on Sunday, October 16, from 1 – 4 PM

Rich moved to have the MVRRHs open and share half of any donations receiver with the Alzheimer's group. Second by Wally V. , approved.

LAYOUTS: O Gauge (Rich H.): Rich expressed gratitude to Bill H. for assistance with wiring the outside main. The grade approaches are in progress and uncoupling tracks are in place. Inside main grades are

underway and the last \$70 wire purchase was made.

HO Scale Layout (Richard T.): Lower level benchwork essentially finished, with some tweaking possible. Backdrop and sub-roadbed will be added next. Additional hardboard (Masonite) and homasote may be needed.

Keith D. reported that the drop wire and zip tie organizers have arrived.

Gary D. announced that AG interlocking near the main yard is done. He also donated a box of cork roadbed.

Geographic naming committee: Eric M., Keith d, Eric H.,

N Scale Layout (Greg M.) Greg was unable to attend.

For the Good of the Order:

Several alternative arrangements for the Christmas Holiday Open House were discussed. As previously noted, Santa and Mrs. Claus must remain within the MVRRHs club space. One plan would have the normally unused door as the primary entrance with the usual entry kept shut and Santa's chair blocking it. A plan to use the operator's office for Santa appears to be favored. The size of the chair will be a determining factor. A tree in the foyer with a G scale train circling beneath may be possible.

Dave E. provided a history of the concourse O gauge layout and relayed \$20 in proceeds from the layout coin box, back in order after cleaning and lubrication by Dave. He plans to rotate a locomotive out of service with a second unit in order to allow for routine maintenance. Scenic upgrades are still needed.

Jon Hebb inquired about a train to raffle. Rich H. reminded the membership of an On30 set donated by Greg M. while we were still at Pleasant Street.
