Minutes of the September 8, 2022 Business Meeting

President Richard T. called the meeting to order at 7 PM with 14 members, including 5 officers, attending.

The meeting began with a statement of gratitude for those members who helped with the successful August 27th – 28th Back to School Open House. A member reported instances of children playing under the HO layout, a potential safety concern and something to be aware of and discouraged in future.

Minutes of the previous meeting:
Keith D. moved to approve the minutes as published in the newsletter, with seconds from Gary D. and Kenton C. Approved as amended to correct a typo – misspelling of a member's name.

Treasurer's report (Keith D.):
Financial transactions and status for the month of August, 2022, including income from the Open House. The MVRRHHS remains solvent and financially sound.

Publicity (Rich H.):
Facebook posts related to the Open House received enthusiastic responses. Followers remain stable in numbers. Recently posted photos garnered multiple likes and shares.

Business Express Ad Cars (Eric H.):

No new accounts. Michael H. suggested that we place the Business Express on the HO layout, perhaps in the staging area, during the next open house or two, while construction continues.

Membership (Rich H.):

Nothing to report.

Donations:

No one had checked the caboose before meeting time.

Old Business: Christmas decoration plans: Keith D. and Rich H. met with Mall management, who are interested in having some sort of display at Center Court. The offer of assistance from MVRRHHS was well received.

Mall concourse O gauge layout: Dave E. will attempt to clean and / or repair the coin slot apparatus in concert with Mall staff. Richard T. suggested conversion to pushbutton and timer operation if the coin box cannot be resurrected.

New Business: None

LAYOUTS: O Gauge (Rich H.): The outer main ran perfectly during the Open House. Construction continues with grades and the tunnel, with some of the inner drops added. Two uncoupling tracks will be installed. Approximately 10 buildings are available with more needed. Some will eventually be illuminated.

HO Scale Layout (Michael H.): Mike circulated a modified plan for the east end staging changes include:

1. Stub end rather than loop construction
2. Reduced footprint allows divider to be closed during open house events to block some noise and

allow for additional sale tables, as we've already been using

3. Operated as staging with an engine escape crossover on arrival track
4. Industrial switching area for use during operating sessions
5. Possible second level above staging

A motion by Mike to accept the HO layout design modification from loop to stub-end staging received a second from Rich H. and unanimous approval with no discussion.

Eric M. continues to make progress laying track as Gary D. progresses with the interlocking and main yard. Risers in the peninsula are now all in place. Supplies: wire expected soon; turnouts – adequate supply for current needs. We may need additional cork roadbed soon. The HO Layout Task Force meets Wednesday, September 14th to discuss operational details, including crossover locations. The team aims to have the lower level running by the December open house. Wire for the HO layout is expected soon. Gary D. offered instructions for bus wiring – rear rail of each track will be white. Any needed color coding of conductors will be accomplished using tape.

N Scale Layout (Greg M.)

Still working on the layout plan, with some discussions of overall preferences taking place. Generally we want to install terrain before laying track. Keith D. offered kudos for the extensive Unitrack layout setup and run during the Open House.
