#### **Membership** (Rich H.):

Keith D. moved to accept Andrew L. as a new member with a second from Gary D. The membership present approved the motion unanimously with no further discussion. Previous member Gavin L. plans to rejoin.

#### **Donations: (Rich H.):**

Our previously unscheduled open house in conjunction with the Eloquence Antiques & Artisans flea market on September 26<sup>th</sup> brought numerous visitors to the Society as well as donations and purchases. Jon H. also reported modest online logo apparel sales during the month.

#### **Facilities:**

Jon H. reported that parts are in for energy monitors, ready to install. Work continues on ceiling tile replacement. Keith D. expects one additional quote on the carpet replacement in the front area of the O and N layout room. Quotes thus far have run high. Consensus now centers on a simple black / gray scheme since matching the existing carpet is impractical. Bids were solicited for new display cases in the lobby area. A carpenter bidding on the cases is due to visit October 15th.

#### **Old Business:**

Members only op session confirmed for October 18<sup>th</sup>, 9am til ... Gary D. expressed the need to refine communications, traffic flow and general problem solving ahead of the traditional January 1<sup>st</sup> op session.

Keith D. reported that new throttles needed for op sessions are on back order.

#### **New Business:**

Keith D. suggested a donation to the Play Room director's fundraising effort to start a new cafe in the Mountaineer Mall. The cafe will offer coffee and pastries. Rich H. moved that the Society donate to the start up fund, seconded by Dave E. Approval was unanimous following discussion of the amount: \$150. Members are excited to have a food option in the Mall for future op sessions and the train show next March. Another new organization is expected to move into the Mall soon.

#### **LAYOUTS:**

#### O Gauge:(Rich H.)

More Sculptamold was laid down in the town area. A farm fence and animals were placed, and Ken. C donated a truck for the layout.

#### **HO Scale:**

Gary D. continues work on track / signal circuitry. Detectors are functioning where installed. Full interlocking is a ways in the future but progress in that direction is steady. West Allegheny staging track controls will be replicated at Greenbrier on the upper level. Track power buss and drop wires will be moved under the benchwork to accommodate the Valley Crossing bridge / viaduct. Eric H. began installing scenic materials on both levels opposite Valley Crossing.

#### N Scale Layout:

Wally V. reported progress on buildings and the backdrop.

#### For the Good of the Order:

Keith D. reported that Mall management has approved the Society's use of the concourse for the train show on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Neighboring business are cooperating and will not schedule conflicting activities. Tables are still needed and some may need to be purchased. Rentals may be available from a local VFD. Bill H. several that he can lend. Vendors will be able to bring their own. Promotional materials will need to go out soon,

including newspapers, paid Facebook ads, flyers to local hobby shops, e.g. Get A Hobby.
